

6<sup>th</sup> – Our Venerable Father, Bessarion, Wonderworker. Because of his virtues and miracles, the Greek writers compare him with Moses, Elias, and others of the Prophets. He is thought to have died before A.D. 400. — Venerable, Hilarion, the "Newer," monk in Dalmatia. He suffered exile for his resistance to the Iconoclasts. He died A.D.

7<sup>th</sup> - St. Theodotus, Priest-Martyr, Bishop of Ancyra. "Wonderworker" was cruelly tortured to death for the Faith.

8<sup>th</sup> – Translation of the Relics of St. Theodore the Great Martyr. (For the other Feast of this Saint, see the 8th day of February) -Our Holv Father, Ephrem, Patriarch of Antioch.

9<sup>th</sup> – Our Holy Father Cyril, Archbishop of Alexandria. (For the other Feast of this Saint, see the 18th day of January) — SS. Thecla, Martha, and Mary, Martyrs, suffered in Persia A.D. 315, in the reign of the Emperor Constantine.

10<sup>th</sup> - St. Timothy, Priest-Martyr, Bishop of Prusia in Bithynia (Asia Minor), suffered death in the persecution under Julian the Apostate, A.D. 362. — Alexander and Antonina, Martyrs.

11<sup>th</sup> - SS. Bartholomew and Barnabas, Apostles. Bartholomew is thought by many to be Nathaniel the "Israelite without guile" of St. John's Gospel. He suffered death in Greater Armenia. His relics are enshrined in his church in Rome (Confer August 25). Barnabas was one of the SS. Seventy disciples. He labored with St. Paul of Antioch., Seleucia, etc., and is said to have been stoned to death by the Jews on the Isle of Cyprus.

12<sup>th</sup> – Our Venerable Father, Onuphrius the Great, Hermit, lived alone for 60 years in the desert of Thebes. He died about A.D. 345, in the reign of Constantius. — Our Venerable Father, Peter of Athos.

13<sup>th</sup> - St. Aquilina, Martyr, suffered death A.D. 117, under the Emperor Trajan. — St. Trephillus, Bishop of Levkusia in Cyprus, suffered at the hands of the Arians, especially because of his loyalty to St. Athanasius. He died about A.D. 370.

14<sup>th</sup> - St. Elisha, Prophet, was of the Tribe of Rubin and son of Saphath B.C. 816. On him fell the mantle of Elias and he continued the work of that great Prophet. In the age of St. Jerome, his grave in Samaria was shown as containing also the body of St. Abdias, the Prophet. He died in the 8<sup>th</sup> century B.C. — Our Holy Father, Methodius, Patriarch of Constantinople, native of Sicily, was induced by the Empress Theodora to accept the See of Constantinople as successor to the Patriarch, Nicephorus. He was celebrated for his sanctity in the Episcopate of his successor, St. Ignatius. He died A.D. 846.

Having celebrated the Feast of Feasts, the Lord's Pascha, and Pentecost 50 days thereafter, we are about to embark upon the Apostles' Fast, which this year begins on June 8, 2020, and ends with the commemoration of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul on June 29. The Apostles' Fast is a prescribed fasting period of the Church, lasting from the day after the Sunday of All Saints to the 29th of June, the feast of the Apostles Peter and Paul. It is a sad truth that many neglect this particular fast for a variety of reasons inconsistent with the apostolic and patristic tradition. Prior to reflecting upon the importance of the Apostles' Fast, a review of the ancient History of this particular fast may help us to recognize its integral place in the life of each and every one.
